### How many people living here live in poverty?

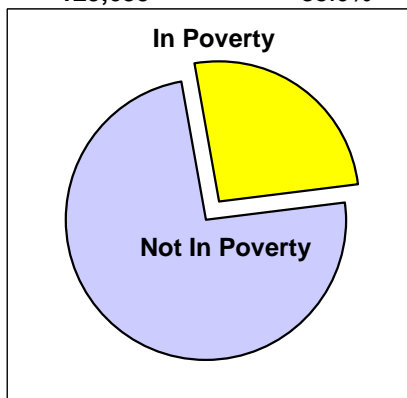
Persons living in poverty: **343,547**

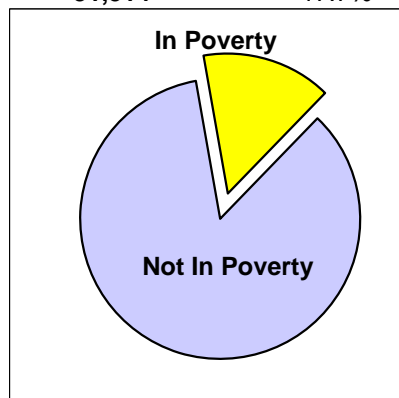
#### Children Under Age 18 in Poverty

**129,639**      **35.0%**



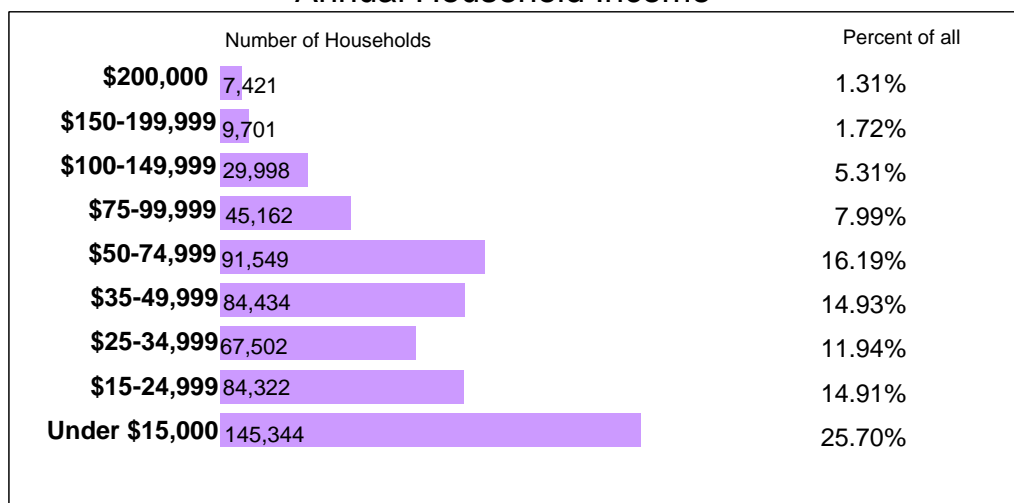
#### Adults Age 65 and Older in Poverty
